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THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Presentation Regarding the District Engineer's Role

Paul Skidmore from Florida Design Consultants reviewed his role as the District's engineer. He stated that SWFWMD inspections are required every two years. Discussion ensued. Mr. Grillo asked for a pond map and Mr. Martin stated that he could provide one to the Board. Mr. McCarthy asked if the pile of concrete that was dumped by the townhomes could be used as rip rap for the ponds. Mr. Skidmore stated that he does not usually recommend this but it would depend on the situation.

Update Regarding Bond Refinancing in 2015

Mr. Cox stated that if the District moves forward, the redemption will be a public offering, senior/subordinate structure scenario. Discussion ensued.
